Check-In/Pick Up

- Every volunteer will have their temperature taken before checking in to Captivate Kids. Our volunteers will not be able to serve if they have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher.
- Our redesigned experience will extend to check-in, as volunteers will help families check-in their child(ren) at the kiosks (*no self check-in*).
- Please practice social distancing while waiting to be checked in.
- We will greet families based on comfort level. If you don't feel comfortable with a contact greeting, simply wave and say hello!

Classroom Sanitization

- We've increased hygiene and cleaning protocols in our kids spaces before, during, and after each service.
- Additional hand-sanitizing stations will be available in the kids check-in and hallway areas.
- All toys and hard surfaces will be sanitized before and after every service.
We ask that you please pick up your child(ren) promptly, in order to allow sufficient time to sanitize properly in between services

Masks

- Required for all volunteers. We ask that they also be worn by parents/guardians (during check-in/pick up), and children in grades 3rd and above. We are able to provide masks if needed.

Of course, we'll need to work together to help keep Captivate Kids a safe place for everyone, so please stay home and participate in church online if your child has had a fever in the past 14 days, shows any symptoms of COVID-19, or has recently been around anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
